This collection of essays continues Barrett's investigations into implementing networked online systems described in his first book Text, ConText, and HyperText, with a more focused emphasis on specific hypermedia systems. In four parts the 22 essays take up designing hypertext and hypermedia systems for the online user; textual intervention and collaboration; new roles for writers; and sensemaking and learning in the online environment. In his introduction, Barrett analyzes the design of networked online systems as part of a collaborative process, asserting that the online environment fosters collaboration by using computer technology to support interaction among those who design, use, and write software. The first five essays present a genealogy of hypertext development, assess various hypertext designs, discuss users' wants and needs, and analyze the rhetoric of hypertext applications in light of new models for computer-human interaction. Seven essays then take up new, important online systems for information retrieval, document production, and training in the online environment. Included are a first-time full-scale analysis of the Athena Muse hypermedia system developed at MIT, the hypertext environment Intermedia, developed...
